April Construction Updates

In early May, construction will begin on the Broadway Avenue Improvement Project. The goal of this two year project is to create a transportation system in Forest Lake that yields a higher degree of safety, efficiency, and mobility for users. It will also include pedestrian and aesthetic enhancements that will be inviting for consumers, travelers, and the community.

Construction Plan in 2011:

- Reconstruct Broadway Avenue Bridge and Ramps at I-35 (Bridge to reopen Fall 2011)
- Construct new backage road behind north side businesses (This is an extension of NW 1st Avenue)
- Reconstruct Broadway Avenue from 19th Street to 8th Street (One lane of traffic in each direction will remain open during construction)
- Complete CR 83 Overpass and new Hardwood Creek Pedestrian Bridge over Broadway Avenue

Construction Plan in 2012:

- Reconstruct Broadway Avenue from 8th Street to Centennial Drive (One lane of traffic in each direction will remain open during construction)
- Construct Hardwood Creek Pedestrian Bridge over CR 83
